Small Group Discussion Questions

Luke 12:13-21

- 1. What you want reveals what you value, and what you value reveals what has your heart.** What are some desires in your own life that, if you are honest, might be quietly shaping your priorities more than you realized?
- 2. Your net worth will never come close to your soul's worth.** Why do you think it is so easy to let income or possessions become tied to a sense of identity or value? What helps you separate the two?
- 3. God is looking for someone to bless so He can reappropriate blessing.** When you think about the increase in your own life, whether financial or otherwise, how often do you pause to ask why God gave you more than you need?
- 4. God did not bless you to raise your standard of living only, but to raise your standard of giving.** What would it look like, in practice, for you to receive a blessing with gratitude while also releasing it with generosity?
- 5. Don't just leave it, leverage it.** Everything you accumulate will eventually be reallocated. How does that truth change the way you think about using your resources now instead of just holding onto them?
- 6. It's not what you leave behind, it's what you send ahead.** What is one way you could invest what God has given you, time, money, or influence, into something that outlasts your own life?

Takeaway: Everything you gain will change hands. Everything you give can change lives.
