"Breakthrough: Something New"

(Isaiah 43:18-19)

<u>Text</u> – "Do not remember the past events; pay no attention to things of old. Look, I am about to do something new; even now it is coming. Do you not see it? Indeed, I will make a way in the wilderness, rivers in the desert." (CSB)

Introduction –After much <u>Suffering</u> and four centuries of <u>Silence</u> – God did something <u>New</u>.
