Small Group Discussion Questions

Isaiah 9:6

- 1. The name El Gibbor means “Mighty God.”** How does seeing God as mighty and victorious change the way you approach the challenges or battles you are facing today?
- 2. God is described as the One who delivers, defends, and defeats every enemy.** Which of those truths do you most need to hold onto in this season of your life, and why?
- 3. We often try to handle life's burdens in our own strength.** What are some signs that you are relying on yourself instead of depending on God's strength?
- 4. God promises strength for our weakness, our fears, our soul, and our journey.** Which of those areas do you need His strength in most right now?
- 5. Scripture teaches that God's work is accomplished not by human power but by His Spirit.** What is one area of your life where you need to surrender control and trust God more fully?
- 6. Philippians 4:13 reminds us that Christ strengthens His people.** What is one step of faith or obedience you believe God is calling you to take this week, trusting His strength instead of your own?

Takeaway

You do not have to live the Christian life in your own strength. The Mighty God has already given you His power through His presence, so walk in faith and depend on Him each day.
