Title: Paid In Full **Text:** Ephesians 1:7-8

Target: To live no longer bound by what weighs you down

I. You have been Purchased by the Blood:

"In him we have redemption through his blood," (Vs. 7a)

A. A Redemption was Required:

- **1. Sin was Slavery:** "Jesus answered them, 'Truly, truly, I say to you, everyone who practices sin is a slave to sin." (John 8:34)
- 2. Justice was Required: "For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord." (Romans 6:23)

B. The Price was Perfection:

- **1. His Sinlessness:** "For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin." (Hebrews 4:15)
- **2. His Substitution:** "For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God." (2 Cor. 5:21)
- **C. Joy of Justification:** "Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ." (Romans 5:1)

Discussion Question: When you hear the word "redemption," what comes to mind from your own life?

(Cross-Reference: John 8:34 – how have you seen sin function like slavery in your own story?)

Discussion Question: What lies or past mistakes try to convince you that you're not fully redeemed?

(Invite your community group to reflect on Romans 6:23 and the cost Jesus paid.)

Discussion Question: Romans 5:1 says we have peace with God. If that's true, what's keeping you from resting in that peace today?

(Encourage journaling or silent reflection before answering aloud.)

II. You have been Pardoned from Every Trespass:

"the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of his grace," (Vs. 7b)

- **A. Sin forever Settled:** "He has delivered us from the domain of darkness and transferred us to the kingdom of his beloved Son, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins." (Col. 1:13-14)
- **B. Victory over Sin:** "For sin will have no dominion over you, since you are not under law but under grace." (Romans 6:14)
- C. Free from Guilt/Shame: "I will remember their sins and their lawless deeds no more." (Hebrews 10:17)

Discussion Question: What sin from your past do you struggle to believe is truly forgiven?

(Hebrews 10:17 – God says He remembers it no more... Why do we still remember?)

Discussion Question: What does victory over sin look like in your life right now? Is it something you feel or only believe?

(Romans 6:14 – explore what "no dominion" means practically.)

Discussion Question: In what ways do guilt and shame still have a seat at your table? What would it look like to remove them?

III. You have been Provided Fresh Revelation:

"which he lavished upon us, in all wisdom and insight." (Vs. 8)

- A. Guaranteed Wisdom: "all wisdom" "If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask God, who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given him." (James 1:5)
- **B. Abounding Insight:** "insight" "Now we have received not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might understand the things freely given us by God." (1 Cor. 2:12)

Discussion Question: Where in your life right now do you feel stuck or confused, needing God's wisdom?

(James 1:5 – Have you asked Him? If not, why?)

Discussion Question: How have you experienced the Spirit helping you "understand the things freely given to you by God"?

(1 Cor. 2:12 – Do you recognize God's voice when He gives insight?)

Discussion Question: How would your week look different if you truly lived as someone who is already free, forgiven, and full of wisdom from God?

(Tie it all together—what practical step could you take this week to walk in that reality?)

Takeaway: Live like it is finished, it is done, the victory has been won!

Personal Challenge:

Identify one lie you've believed about yourself that contradicts your redemption in Christ. Write a Scripture next to it that tells the truth.

Prayer Prompt:

"Jesus, thank You for paying in full. Help me to live like I'm free, forgiven, and full of Your Spirit."
