TITLE: Inspired or Expired?

TEXT: 2 Timothy 3:16-17

TARGET: The Bible is not just inspiring —it is *inspired*; it is not just relevant—it is *revelation*.

Plenary Verbal Inspiration:

Plenary: All parts of the Bible equally inspired by God, not just sections

Verbal: means the Inspiration extends to the specific, individual words, not just thoughts or concepts

3 Greek expressions for the Word of God:

Graphe: the manuscript, the manual, the actual words that make up the Bible

Logos: meaning & message behind the words (graphe)

Rema: declarative, spoken, authoritative Word of God.

I. <u>INTERNAL</u> EVIDENCE—found within the pages of the Bible itself & how it came to be written.

A. Author's Unity-

- 40 authors: shepherds, prophets, kings, fisherman, doctor, scholar, prisoner, military leader, cup bear
- 66 books: 39 Old Testament & 27 New Testament
- OT was written before Jesus was born & NT was written after His death, burial & resurrection
- 1,500 years; the earliest books were penned 1,400 years before Jesus' birth
- 3 languages: Hebrew (OT), Aramaic (part OT), Greek (NT)
- 3 continents: Asia, Africa, Europe
- **B. Doctrinal Consistency**-Jesus Christ is the center of the storyline
- Creation of the universe
- Fall of man
- Redemption of mankind
- Redemption of God's creation

C. Functional Sufficiency-

- Teaching: foundation of our doctrine (what is right)
- Reproof: exposes our sin (what is not right?)
- Correction: provides the solution for our sin (how to get right)
- Training: ongoing spiritual growth (how to stay right)

- **D.** Fulfilled Prophecy-Historical & Messianic; 30% of the Bible is prophecy
- Daniel 9:25-timeframe when the messiah would come
- Micah 5:2-Jesus will be born in Bethlehem
- Zachariah 11:12–13-Jesus betrayed for 30 pieces of silver
- Psalms 22:16-Jesus, his hands and feet would be pierced when crucified
- E. Miraculous Validity-100's of witnessed & recorded miracles
- The resurrection of Jesus witnessed by 500+ people
- F. Divine Authority-Inspired by God
- Inspiration=supernatural influence exerted by the Holy Spirit of God on human writers
- The Bible is trustworthy because of the source of the words, not the scribes who penned them

II. EXTERNAL EVIDENCE— found outside or apart from the Bible

A. Archaeological

- 1. Tel Dan Steele (900-850 BC)-King David
- 2. Moabite Stone (846 BC)-King David, King Omri, Yahweh
- 3. Carbonized loaves of bread (7th-8th century AD): With gratitude to the blessed Jesus

B. Historical

- 1. Dead Sea Scrolls (250 BC-AD 68)
- Scroll=pieces of parchment or papyrus connected together to create one long piece that is rolled
- Super preservation of Scripture
- When compared with Modern Hebrew bible, was word-for-word accurate
- 2. Aleppo Codex & Leningrad Codex (AD 1000)
- Codex= sheet of parchment or papyrus stacked on top of each other similar to our modern book style
- Source of Modern Hebrew bible

C. Scientific

- 1. Astronomy- Earth is round (Isaiah 40:22)
- **2.** *Geology* Water Cycle (Ecclesiastes 1:7; Isaiah 55:10)
- **3.** *Biology* Blood necessary for life (Leviticus 17:11)
- 4. Time, Space & Matter- (Genesis 1:1)
- In the beginning= time
- God created the heaven= space
- And the Earth= matter

III. <u>ETERNAL</u> EVIDENCE—eternal evidence exists because God is eternal

A. God

- 1. God is eternal (1 Timothy 1:17)
- 2. God's Word is eternal (Isaiah 40:8)
- Psalm 138:2-God exalts His Word higher than His own Name, meaning His Word represents Him more fully than His Name alone can do.

B. You

- 1. New Creation (2 Corinthians 5:17)
- Have a testimony to share
- 2. Spiritual Growth (2 Peter 3:18)
- 3. Eternal Life (Romans 6:23)

Takeaway: The Bible does not simply *inform* you; it *transforms* you.
