Small Group Discussion Questions

Matthew 7:24-29

- 1. Jesus said everyone who hears His words either applies them or ignores them, and there is no third option.** Why do you think hearing and knowing the truth can feel like enough, even when nothing changes in how we live? Where have you noticed that gap between hearing and doing in your own life?
- 2. Two people can build houses that look nearly identical on the outside, yet one stands on rock and the other on sand.** What are some foundations people build their lives on that look solid on the surface but cannot hold up under real pressure?
- 3. Rain, floods, and wind come for both houses. The storm itself is not optional.** Think of a storm you have walked through. Looking back, what did that season reveal about what you were actually standing on?
- 4. One house stands strong. The other falls suddenly and completely.** Why do you think collapse so often feels sudden, even when the foundation was weak for a long time before the storm arrived?
- 5. Your foundation determines your future.** In practical terms, what does it look like this week to dig deeper into a foundation built on obedience rather than just agreement?
- 6. Dig deep, stand strong.** What is one area of your life right now where you sense God inviting you to dig deeper rather than build fast?
