

Title: I Know That Song!

Text: Exodus 14, 15, Revelation 15

Target: God turns every battle into songs of victory.

1. **The Battle Belongs to the Lord: (Exodus 14:13-14)** *“And Moses said to the people, ‘Fear not, stand firm, and see the salvation of the Lord, which he will work for you today. For the Egyptians whom you see today, you shall never see again. The Lord will fight for you, and you have only to be silent.’”*
 - a. **Fear is not of God:** *“Fear Not”*
 - b. **Stand in His Strength:** *“See the Salvation of the Lord”*
 - c. **Watch Him Work:** *“Today”*
 - d. **God Fights for you:** *“Will fight for you”*

2. **A Melody becomes the Memorial: (Exodus 15:1-6)**
 - a. **The Lord is Victorious:** *“Then Moses and the people of Israel sang this song to the Lord,”* (Exodus 15:1)
 - b. **The Lord is my Savior:** *“The Lord is my strength and my song, and he has become my salvation; this is my God, and I will praise him, my father’s God, and I will exalt him.”* (Exodus 15:2)
 - c. **The Lord is a Warrior:** *“The Lord is a man of war; The Lord is his name.”* (Exodus 15:3)
 - d. **The Lord Reigns Forever:** *“The Lord will reign forever and ever.”* (Exodus 15:18)

3. **Heaven Sings a Familiar Song:** *“And they sing the **song of Moses**, the servant of God, and the **song of the Lamb**, saying, ‘Great and amazing are your deeds, O Lord God the Almighty! Just and true are your ways, O King of the nations!’”* (Revelation 15:3)
 - a. **Sovereign over the Seas:** *“And I saw what appeared to be a sea of glass...”* (Revelation 15:2a)
 - b. **Faithful through the Fire:** *“mingled with fire”* (Revelation 15:2b)
 - i. **These are Tribulation Saints:** *“those who had conquered the beast”* (Revelation 15:2c)
 - ii. **Refusing to Bow the Knee:** *“number of its name”* (Revelation 15:2d)
 - iii. **Martyred for the Name of Christ:** *“Also I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded for the testimony of Jesus and for the word of God, and those who had not worshiped the beast or its image and had not received its mark...”* (Revelation 20:4)
 - c. **Song of the Lamb:** *“Song of the Lamb”* (Revelation 15:3b)
 - i. **Satan is forever Defeated:** *“and the devil who had deceived them was thrown into the lake of fire and sulfur where the beast and the false prophet were, and they will be tormented day and night forever and ever.”* (Revelation 20:10)
 - ii. **Word of our Testimony:** *“And they have conquered him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, for they did not love their lives even unto death.”* (Revelation 12:11)

Takeaway: God always gets the final song!
