Small Group Discussion Questions

Genesis 22:1-14

- 1. Abraham obeyed God immediately and without explanation.** What is the hardest part for you personally about obeying God when He doesn't explain why?
- 2. Abraham told his servants, "We will come back," believing God would provide even if Isaac died.** Describe a time when you had to trust God with an outcome you could not see or control.
- 3. Isaac willingly surrendered himself on the altar.** What is one thing in your life right now that God may be asking you to lay down and fully surrender to Him?
- 4. God provided the ram at the very last moment.** Has there been a time in your life when God's provision came at what felt like the very last second? How did that experience shape your faith?
- 5. God's silence never means He is absent.** How do you personally handle seasons when God feels silent? What helps you keep trusting Him during those times?
- 6. Genesis 22 points forward to Jesus in so many ways — the only son, the third day, the wood, Mount Moriah.** How does seeing Jesus in this story deepen your confidence that God's got you in whatever you are facing today?
