Directions to Camp Eagle from San Antonio:

(PLEASE ARRIVE PREPARED)- THE CLOSEST GAS STATION/STORE IS 23 MILES!

- Take Hwy I-10 West towards Boerne, past Kerrville.
- Exit Mile Marker 490.
- Turn left under the bridge and proceed West on Hwy 41 - [Hwy 41, Mountain Home/Rocksprings].
- Drive approximately 2 miles, cross-over Hwy 27, drive 22 miles to the intersection of Hwy 41 and Hwy 83.
- Continue Westbound on Hwy 41 for 16 miles; turn left onto Hackberry Road [dirt road]. There is signage for Camp Eagle at Hackberry Road.
- Drive approximately 8 miles to the entrance of Camp Eagle [dirt road].

Camp Eagle Important Information

Items TO bring:

- **Bible and Writing Materials:** notepad, paper, pencils/pens.
- **Bedding:** pillows, sheets or sleeping bag.
- **Clothing:** jacket- [for cool weather], shoes- [comfortable], swimsuit, etc.
- **Toiletries:** bath/wash towels, shampoo/soap, toothbrush/toothpaste, shaving kit, etc.
- **Sports:** (fishing) your equipment and license; (Mountain Biking)- if you plan on touring the Hill Country you **MUST** bring your own mountain bike and helmet; (Skeet Shooting)- your own shotgun [*ammo and clays WILL be provided]; in addition, any other sporting equipment you may want to bring.
- **Extras:** cash/ for soda machine; personal snacks; flashlight; insect repellent; sunscreen.

****A helmet is required to be worn at Camp Eagle at all times when riding a bike.***

****If bringing your own CPAP machine, you will need to bring your own extension cord.***
