

Title: Unknown Sin

Text: Psalm 51:10-12, 1 John 1:9, Psalm 139:23-24

Target: We serve a God that forgives all sin when we seek forgiveness and confess it. There is a freedom found in making known what you tried to keep unknown. God declares you fully known, but yet fully loved.

I. You are Fully Known

- **Camouflage Effect: Rationalized** (Genesis 3:8)
- **Cover-Up Effect: Justified** (Joshua 7:19-20)
- **Concealer Effect: Capitalized** (2 Samuel 12:12)
- **Censor Effect: Moralized** (John 8:6-8)

Key Verse: Numbers 32:23: *“be sure your sin will find you out.”*

Key Principle: When we choose to not deal with our sins privately, God will choose to deal with our sins publicly.

II. You are Fully Loved

- **Confession caused Holiness:** (1 John 1:9)
- **Confession cultivates Humility** (James 4:6)
- **Confession causes Healing** (James 5:16)
- **Confession compels Habitudes** (Titus 2:7)

Key Verse: Proverbs 28:13: *“Whoever conceals his transgressions will not prosper, but he who confesses and forsakes them obtains mercy.”*

Key Principle: Choosing to operate in confession before God ushers in the compassion of God.
