Text: Mark 5:21-43

Target: In waiting for our breakthrough, Jesus is working.

I. The Interruption of _____: “Then came one of the rulers of the synagogue, Jairus by name, and seeing him, he fell at his feet.” (Mark 5:22)

A. Person of Distinction: “ruler of the synagogue” (Vs. 22)

B. Place of Desperation: “implored him earnestly, saying “my little daughter is at the point of death” (Vs. 23)

C. Plea of Determination: “Come and lay your hands on her, so that she may be made well and live.” (Vs. 23b)

II. The Interruption of _____: “And there was a woman who had had a discharge of blood for **twelve** years.” (Mark 5:25)

A. Identified by her Condition: “woman”

B. Inflicted due to her Condition: “suffered much under many physicians, and had spent all that she had.” (Vs. 26a)

C. Isolated because of her Condition: “was no better but rather grew worse” (Vs. 26b)

III. The Interruption to an _____: “For she said, “If I touch even his garments, I will be made well.” (Vs. 28)

A. Divine Deliverance: “*immediately* the flow of blood dried up,” (Vs. 29)

B. Direct Discernment: “And Jesus, perceiving in himself that power had gone out... *immediately* turned to the crowd and said, “who touched my garments?” (Vs. 30)

C. Declaration of Destiny: “Daughter, your faith has made you well; go in peace, and be healed of your disease.” (Vs. 34)

IV. The Interruption of _____: “While he was still speaking, there came from the ruler’s house some who said, “Your daughter is dead. Why trouble the Teacher any further?” (Vs. 35)

A. Don’t Lose Faith: “Jesus, said to the ruler of the synagogue, “Do not fear, only believe” (Vs. 36)

B. Time has Not Run Out: “The child is not dead but sleeping” (Vs. 39)

C. Impossible Doesn’t Exist: “*immediately* the girl got up and began walking (for she was **twelve** years of age), and they were *immediately* overcome with amazement.” (Vs. 42)

Takeaway: The Interruption makes way for the “Immediately”
