- Read Luke 15:12-32 as a family.
- What stands out to you from these verses?
- What does prodigal mean? To spend lavishly and foolishly
- What led the prodigal to leave his father?
- How does it make you feel knowing that we can always find forgiveness when we turn to Jesus?

Live It Out: What is God saying to me?

- Is there an area of your life that hasn't been honoring to God?
 - How can you turn from that, and be more obedient in your walk with Christ this week?
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Equip: Take it further.

- Share the story of the prodigal son with a friend this week.
